### Scarlet Fever and Measles

There have been a few cases of Scarlet Fever in school.

Symptoms include:

- flushed face
- strawberry tongue, or a white tongue with red dots on the surface
- red, sore throat with white and yellow patches
- lines or streaks around the armpits, elbows and knees
- fever above 101°F (38.3°C)
- chills
- headaches
- swollen tonsils

Lancashire County Council have also asked that we warn parents about an outbreak of Measles.

Symptoms of Measles include:

- a runny or blocked nose
- sneezing
- watery eyes
- swollen eyelids
- sore, red eyes that may be sensitive to light
- high temperature (fever)
- small greyish-white spots in the mouth
- aches and pains
- general lack of energy
