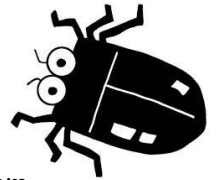
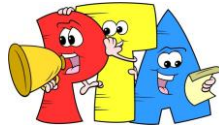
Celebration Worship
