FUNDRAISING UPDATE

By the end of the school year we hope to have raised in excess of £3,500 from our various events and match funding.

At Easter the PTFA funded an Easter Egg hunt at the school organised and led by Mr Clare. This event was enjoyed by all of the children and we hope to be able to fund future events for all of the children to enjoy alongside our usual money raising events.

What will the funds raised be spent on?

So far this year funds have been spent on various areas in school which benefit our children. See below:

- Music: new equipment was desperately needed and has been purchased. This includes new glockenspiels, recorders and ukuleles. An element of funds also go towards music licencing which is needed and helps the school play songs etc that are needed for the children's various lessons and assemblies.
- There are further plans for our funds to be spent based on requirements into next school year. These will be discussed by the PTFA AGM in September.

The PTFA had originally planned to use the vast majority of funds raised this year to repair/replace the outdoor play equipment on the school field but following a generous donation of both time and funds from a parent this has been completed without the use of PTFA funds. At the AGM ideas will be presented for how we should use this money.
