

# **Uniform Policy**

The staff, governors and parents support the wearing of a School Uniform. The children at Aughton St Michael's CE are very proud to belong to our school and the uniform re-enforces this sense of identity. As with all other areas of school, we expect very high standards and encourage children to take pride in their appearance. Therefore, the following Policy has been agreed.

## Autumn & Spring Terms

- White Polo shirt. This can be one purchased from school with the school badge stitched on or a plain white polo shirt from any retailer.
- **Green Sweatshirt** or **Cardigan** with school badge. This can only be purchased from Premier Sports (or the school office whilst stocks last).
- Grey Trousers, Shorts, Pinafore or Skirt purchased from any retailer.
- Grey Socks purchased from any retailer. Grey tights may be worn in cold weather.
- Sensible Black School Shoes (not trainers or boots). For Health and Safety reasons shoes must have either a supporting strap, laces or Velcro and not be the slip-on type. They must be flat shoes, not these with heels. Sports brands (i.e. Nike, Adidas) are not allowed as these tend to be a trainer which is not school uniform.
- **Coats** can be any colour as long as they are warm and rainproof. Fashion coats or those with inappropriate wording are not acceptable.

## Summer Term

Children can continue to wear their autumn and spring uniform, or the following options can be taken up in the hotter summer months.

- A green gingham school dress or playsuit.
- Short white socks

#### Hair

Sensible haircuts only. No tram lines or extreme shaved styles. Long hair (hair that touches the shoulder) must be tied back. Long hair must be secured appropriately with simple, plain, hair bands or bobbles in either green, white, black or brown (This is in line with school colours).

## Jewellery

The only jewellery allowed is a wristwatch and 1 set of stud earrings that the child must be able to remove for PE.

#### Make up

- No make up is allowed. If a child comes to school with make up they will be asked to remove it before they can attend lessons.
- No nail varnish is to be worn. If a child comes to school with nail varnish on they will be asked to remove it before they can attend lessons

### Physical Education (PE) Kit

The kit for all children in these year groups is:

- Green School PE T-shirt with school logo. This can only be purchased from Premier Sports.
- **Black shorts**. These can be purchased from Premier Sport or any other retailer. They must not be branded.
- **Plain black jogging bottoms** (*optional for outdoor PE during the winter months*). These can be purchased at any retailer.
- **Green hooded sweatshirt** with school logo. This can only be purchased from Premier Sports. This is optional for outdoor PE during the winter months. A school sweatshirt or cardigan can also be worn.
- **Black Trainers**. These should be Velcro for any child that cannot tie their own laces. Please do not send in high-value, fashion trainers.
- Please note that leggings or cycling shorts are not appropriate.

#### Naming Clothes

All items of clothing must be clearly marked with your child's name. This cannot be stressed too clearly. We collect a vast amount of unnamed lost property.
