INFORMING SCHOOL OF YOUR CHILD'S ABSENCE

Many apologies to those of you who have been trying to ring school to inform us of your child's absence and not been able to leave a message.

From Monday 31<sup>st</sup> January parents will be able to use the School Spider App to report absences on the day, and inform us of any upcoming absence (e.g. medical appointments).

If you have a holiday request, this still need to be request on the official paper form.

To access this feature:

- Log into the app
- Tap the *menu button* (3 horizontal line in the top right-hand corner). This will open the menu box.
- Tap on *Report Absence*. This will show you any previous absences.
- To report a new absence, tap Report Absence in the blue box on the top right.
- Fill in the form and tap *Send to school*. Please ensure you fill in the *reason* box as we will then know how long the absence will run for (e.g. vomit in the night would be a 48-hour absence so you wouldn't have to report it again the next day)

From Monday 31<sup>st</sup> January, this will replace phoning school to report an absence.
