Current COVID Guidance

If a child or young person has a positive COVID-19 test result, we ask that they do not attend school for **3 days after** the day they took the test. After 3 days, if they feel well and **do not have a high temperature**, the risk of passing the infection on to others is much lower. This is because children and young people tend to be infectious to other people for less time than adults.

Symptoms of COVID -19, flu and common respiratory infections include:

- Continuous cough
- High temperature, fever or chills
- Loss of, or change in, your normal sense of taste or smell
- Shortness of breath
- Unexplained tiredness, lack of energy
- Diarrhoea, feeling sick or being sick
- Loss of appetite
- Headache
- Sore throat, runny nose or stuffy nose
- Muscle aches and pains

Children with mild symptoms such as a runny nose, sore throat, or slight cough, who are otherwise well, can continue to attend school.

Children and young people who are unwell and have a high temperature should stay at home and avoid contact with other people, where they can. They can go back to school and resume normal activities when they **no longer have a high temperature**, and they are well enough to attend. If a child has been sick, or has diarrhoea, a period of 48 hours must have passed since they were last sick or their last episode of diarrhoea.
